Prior to her academic appointment, she worked as a Social Development Specialist at the World Bank for the Middle East and North Africa region, and consulted for the International Food Policy Research Institute and OECD. Dr. Finkel's current research focuses on gendered gaps impacting women's public and political participation. Since 2015, she has been collaborating with the United Nations Development Program to expand the availability and quality of data on gender equality in public administration and evidence-based policymaking. Since 2021, she has been leading an interdisciplinary international working group research on Online Violence Against Women in Politics.
